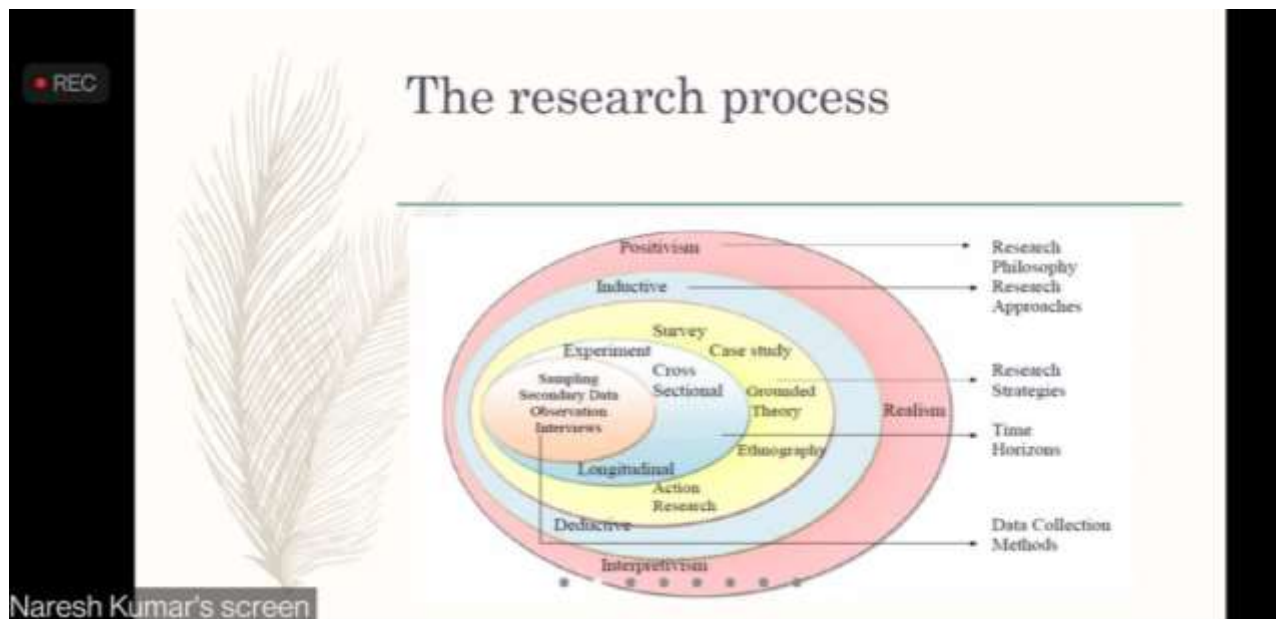


## Report on 5<sup>th</sup> CME
